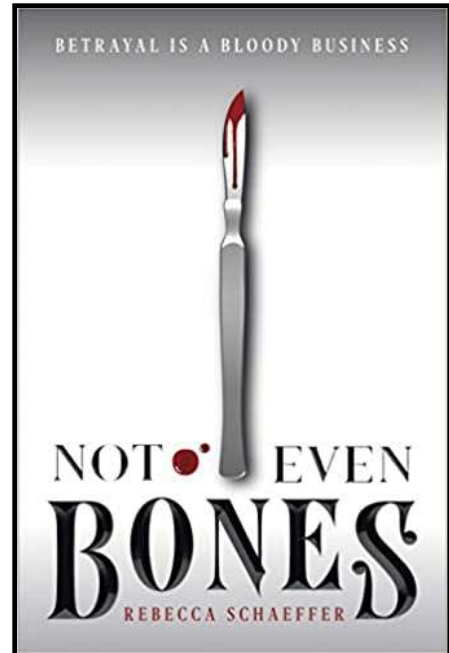


Title: Not Even Bones

Not Even Bones centers on Nita, a 17-year-old living in Peru with her mother. It takes place in a world where there are people called “unnaturals” that seem human, but aren’t. There are different types of unnaturals; for example, some feed on human pain and are considered dangerous and others can simply heal faster. Nita’s mother kills unnaturals and brings them to her daughter so she can dissect them and then sell them on the black market. Eventually, Nita’s mother unexpectedly brings a living boy into her dissection room and Nita is faced with a difficult decision. She could go against her mother and release him or go against her morals and hurt a living person. She has many other difficult moral choices to make throughout the book.
