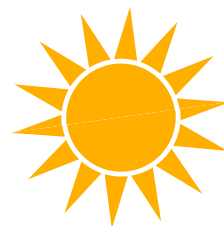

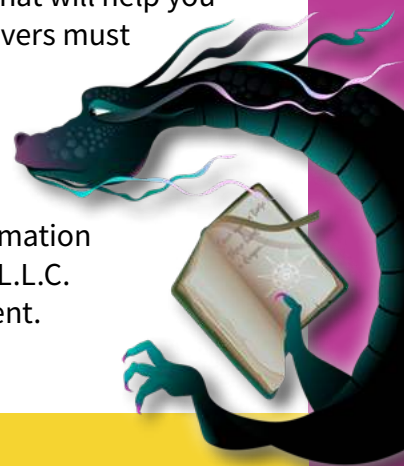

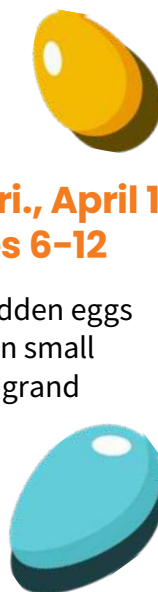


Teen Flashlight Egg Hunt Lock-In

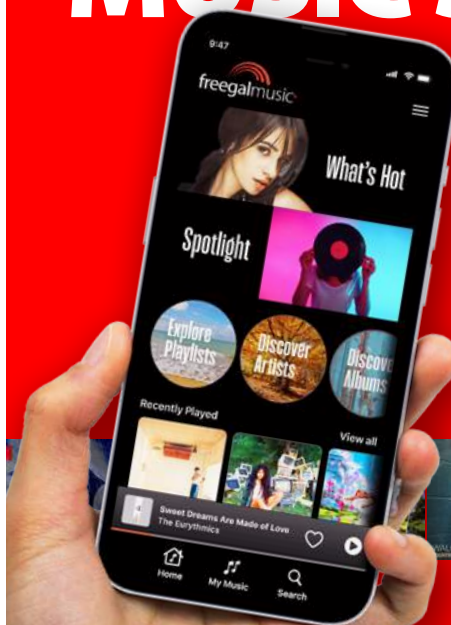
